Important Company Announcement Planned Price Increase

As a result of increasing land values and the strengthening Brazilian currency, with reference to the Euro in particular, Greenwood Management will be adding an annual maintenance fee of 50 Euros per hectare, across the range of it's forestry investment projects in Brazil.

The new management fee will not affect existing clients, whose allocations will continue to be maintained as per their original agreement with the company. Neither will any of the Canadian New Brunswick projects be affected.

The Annual Maintenance fees will commence on the 4th October 2010 and will be charged to all new forestry allocations from this date onwards. Fees will be charged yearly in advance.

The total fees payable based on the new pricing structure are therefore shown in the table below:
